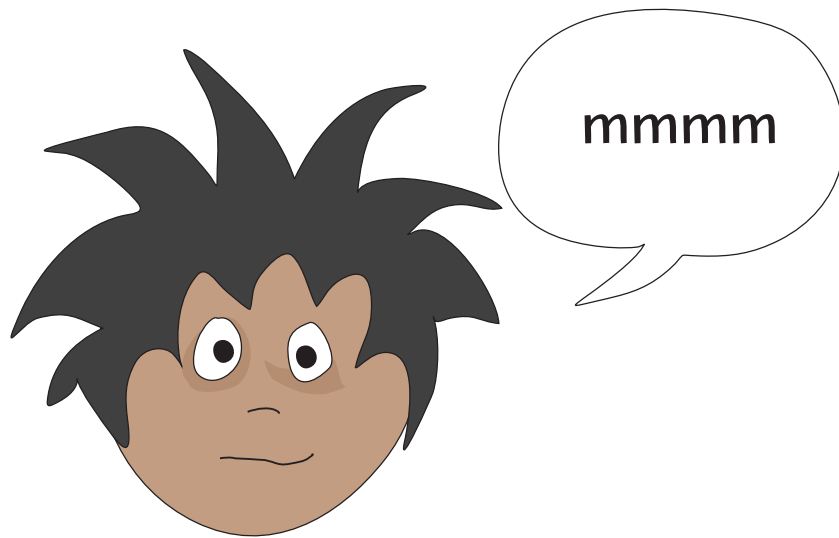

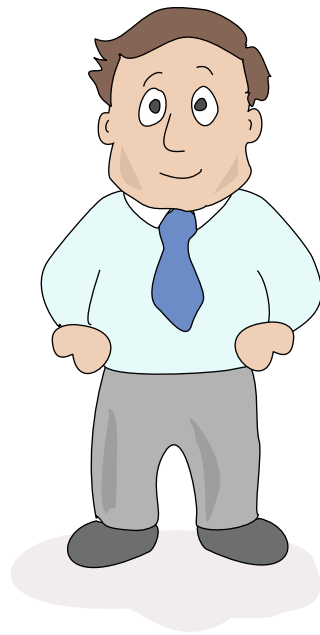
The letter 'm' says, "mmm."

the “mmm” sound...

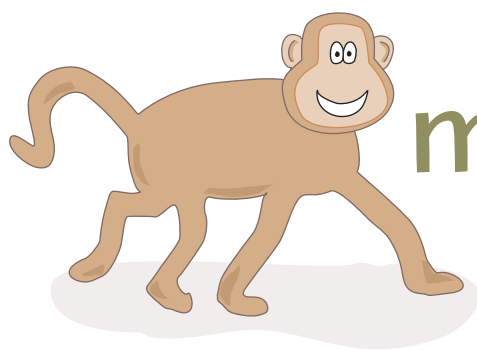

This is important because we want children to practice associating the SOUND of the letter (“mmm”) with the *visual* of the letter.



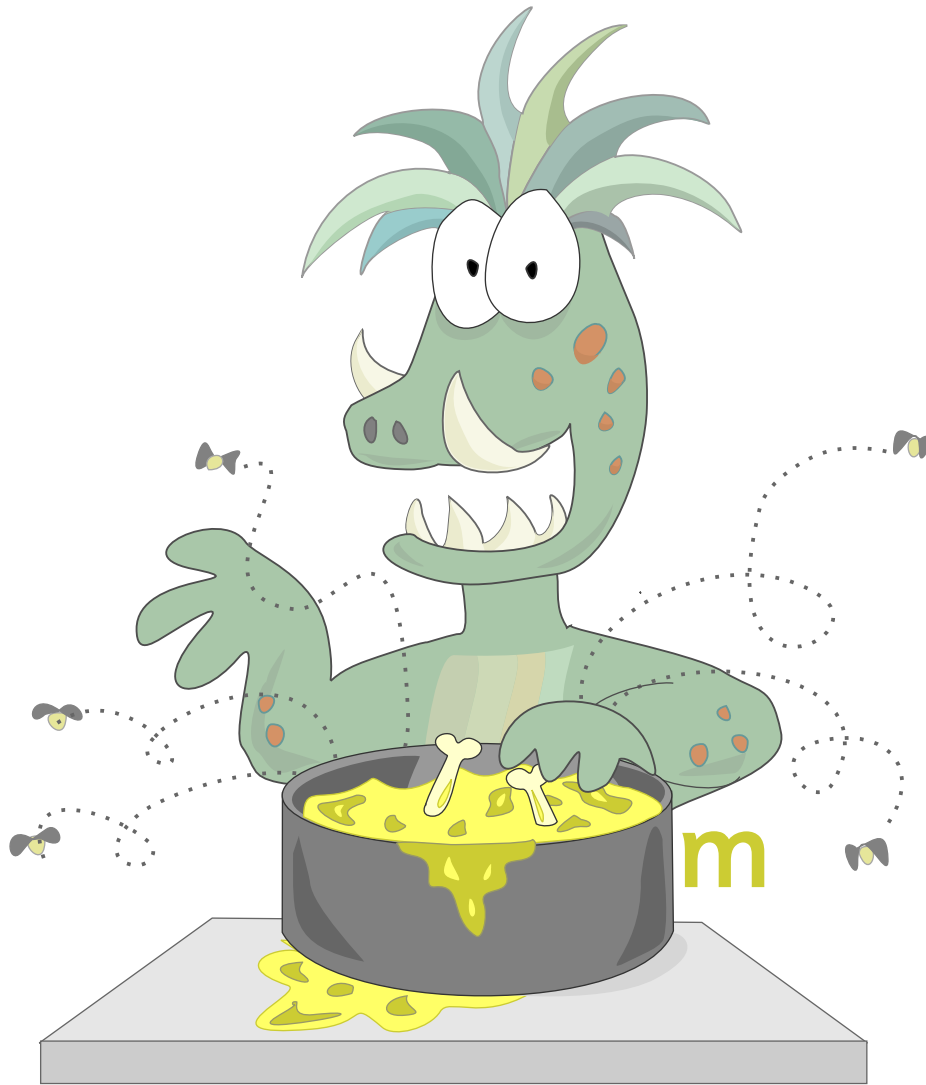
“Oh, no!” said Mister

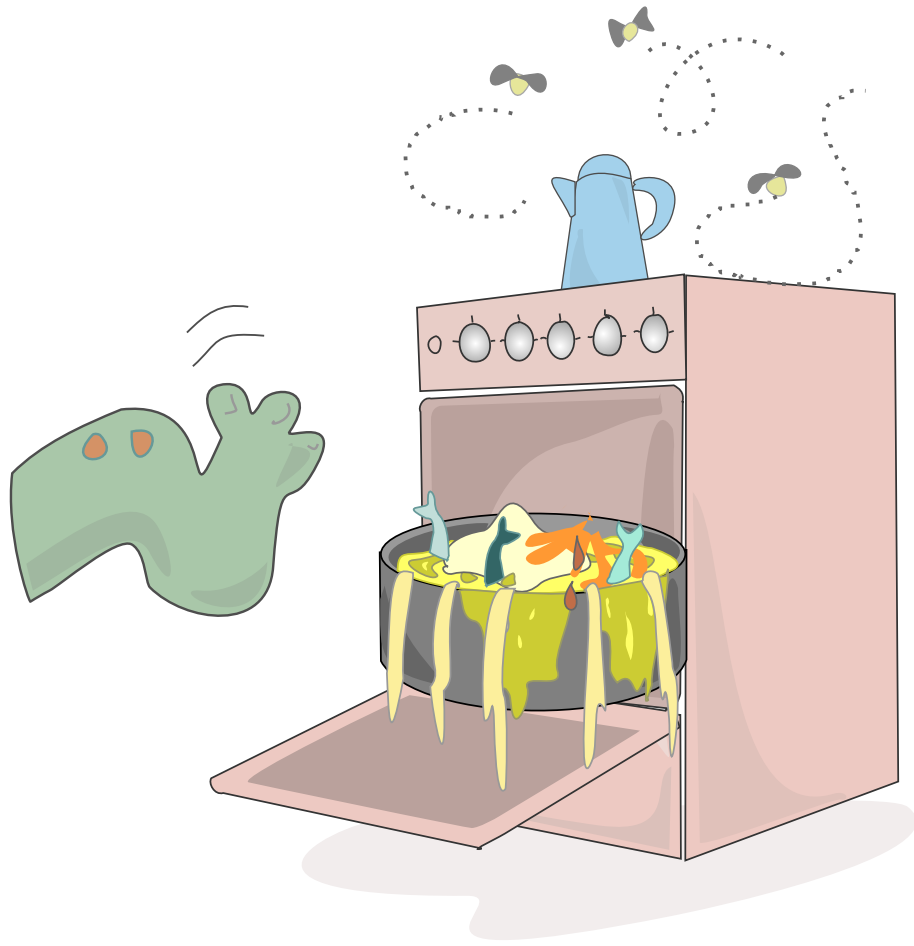
“Now,” said Mister

gave it a kick.

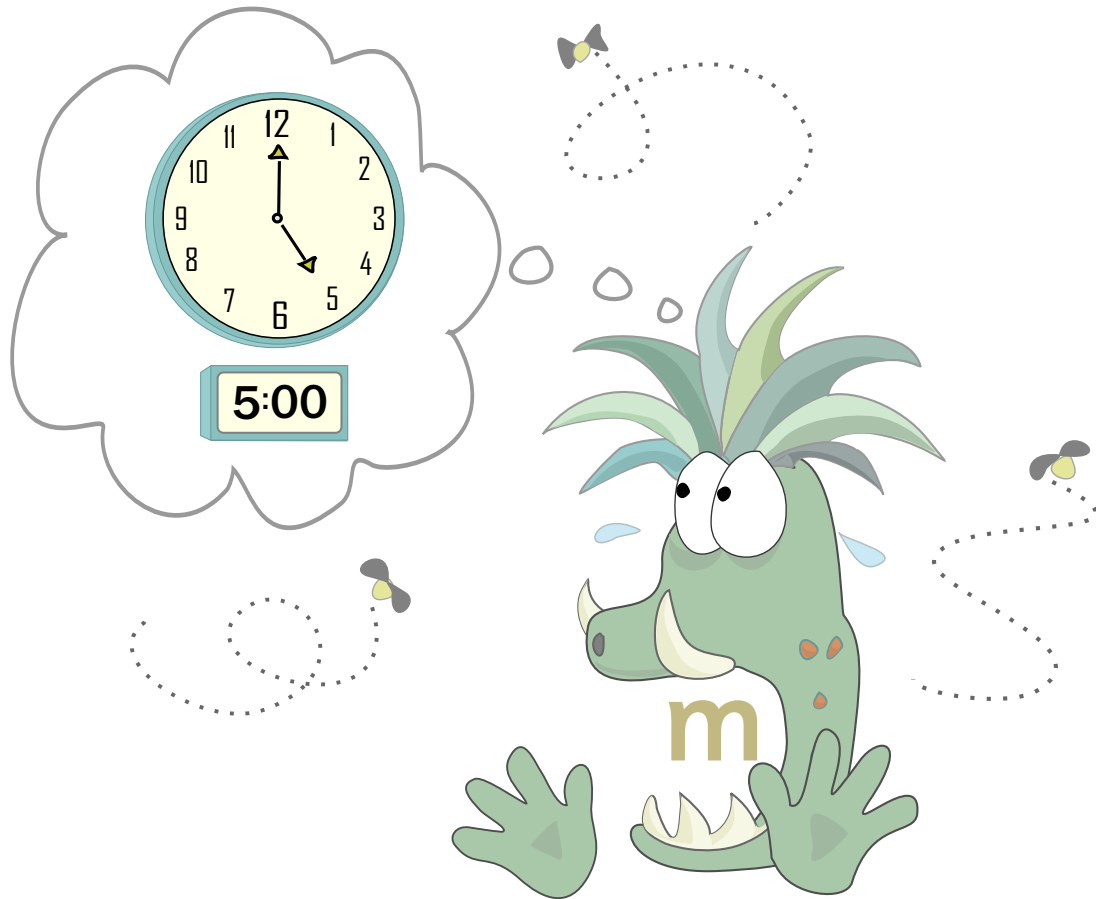


Boom!

🔍 Find another letter ‘m’ hiding in the picture.



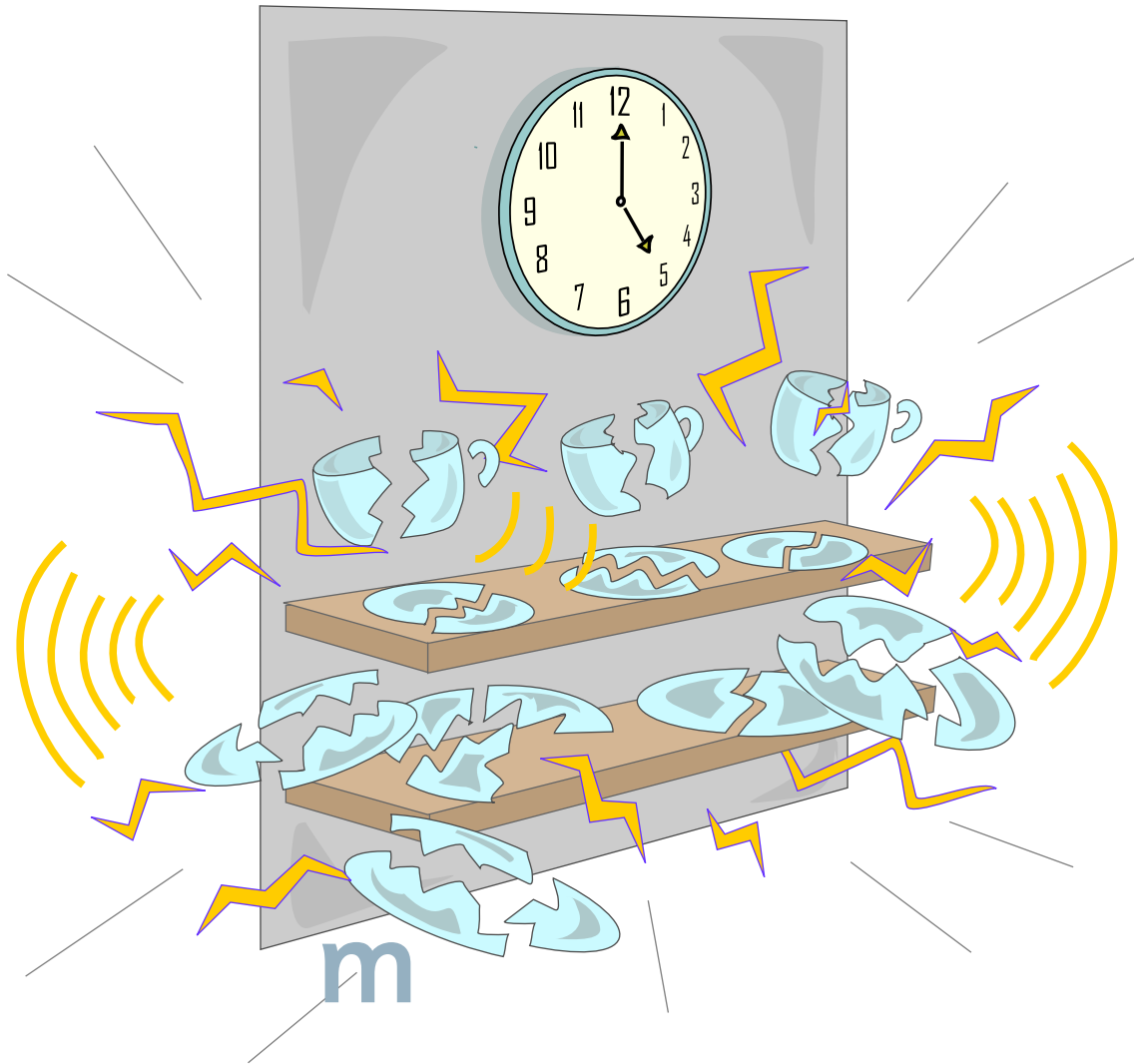
“I will have to cook the

mistake!

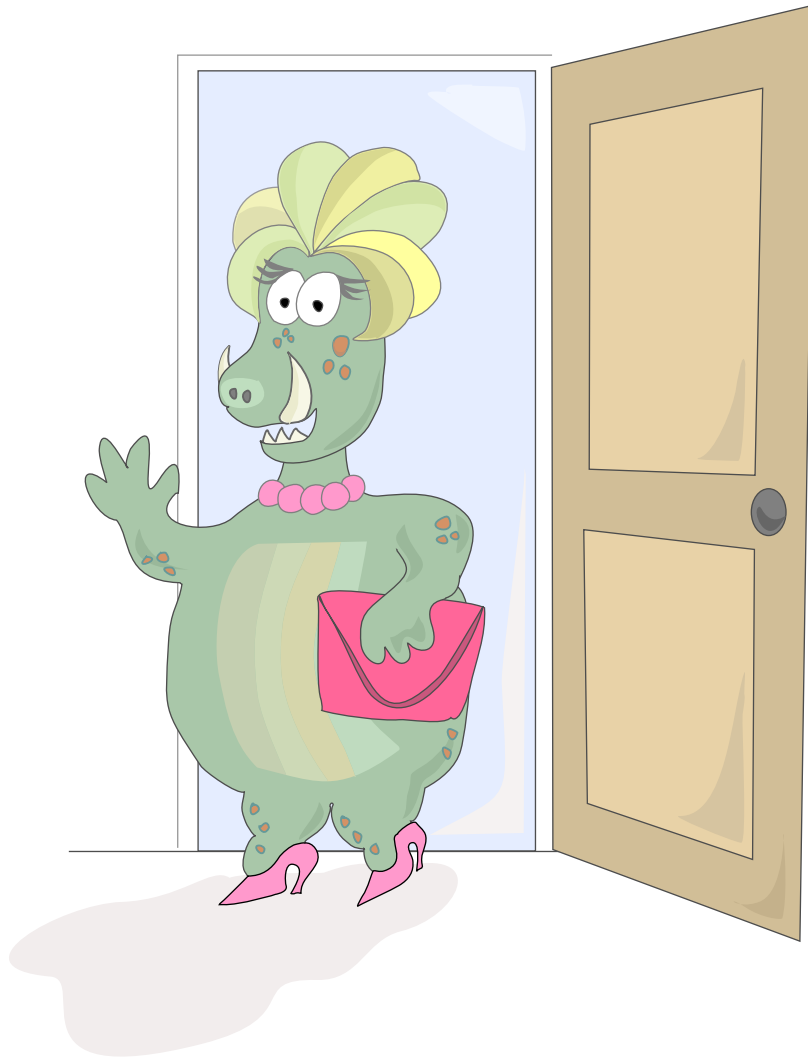


His monster eyes  
broke the plates.

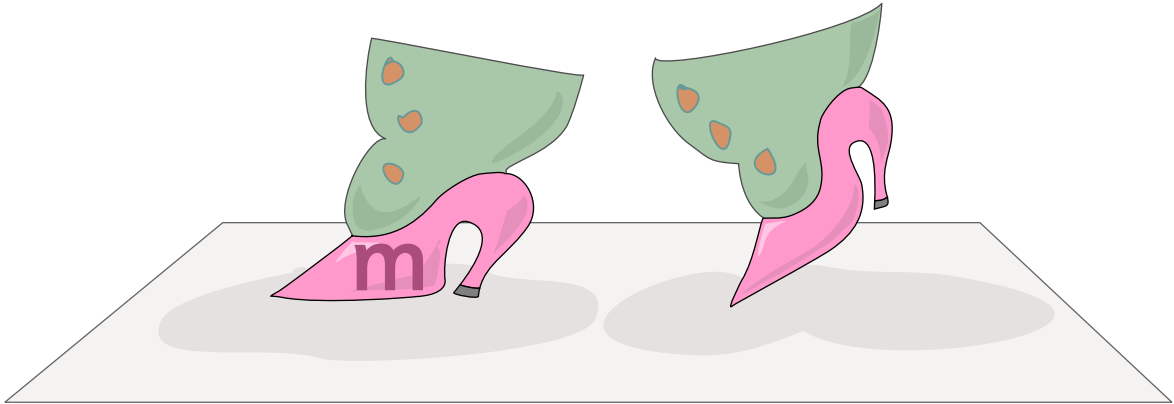
